Rossella Palomba is a social demographer. She is Doctor of research at the National Research Council and Head of the Department on Family and Society at the National Institute for Population Research in Rome. Her main fields of interest are related to the analysis of the changes in the family structure and behaviour, couple formation and dissolution, fertility and gender roles. She has chaired two European networks: one on Population policies, under the auspices of UN-ECE: and one on Population Education, under the auspices of UNESCO. She was a member of the Italian Committee on Economics, Statistics and Sociology and of the Italian National Committee on Environment. She is chairing the Commission for the Improvement of Women in Science at the National Research Council. She has written books and articles on the situation of women in the Italian research system. Her most recent publications are *Population, Family and Welfare*, Oxford, Oxford University Press (2 volumes) and *Figlie di Minerva*, Milano, Franco Angeli. She also co-authored the ETAN Report *Science policies in the European Union - Promoting excellence through mainstreaming gender equality*.
